Your reception will be held in the Fr. O'Hare Hall, a large and modern facility on the West side of St. Joseph's Church grounds. The following Reception options are:

Luncheon Reception*: (10 a.m. funeral, committal following the funeral. Return to the Hall from the cemetery) (**The Hall is available until 2pm**)

Cost: \$6.00 per person (Minimum guests: 25)

Menu:

Hoagie Sandwiches (Turkey, Ham, Salami and Cheese); condiments on the side
Green Garden Salad, Fruit Salad, Broccoli and Bacon Salad, Potato Salad, Relish Trays, Dessert, Coffee, Water and Lemonade.

*All Receptions are served buffet style and include Tablecloths, Table Décor, and Paper Products as well as Set up and Clean-up of the facility.

NOTE: All costs must be paid in full at time of reservation at Church office; no refunds available if less guests attend. For cancellation of reception, refund is only available with a four day notice, as we purchase food in advance. No alcohol or wine is permitted. The Bereavement Reception Coordinator will contact you following your reservation to discuss personal needs. The Hall screen and audio system is available if you would like to bring a DVD with memories of your loved one. If you have any questions following your reservation, please contact the parish office for guidance.

A/V Presentation Information for Parishioners

Families using the Hall for Funeral Receptions also have use of the Hall's audio/video presentation system. Please let staff know ahead of time if you plan to have a media presentation. Below are considerations for using this system.

- We use PC laptops that can read USB storage devices
- The system can play videos/slideshows and play music. Usually in the following formats:
 - JPG, PNG or PDF
 - MP3
 - MP4
- Also, we have Microphones available.
- You may use your own laptop, provided it has an HDMI port.
 - If you bring a MAC you would need proper HDMI adaptor

It is encouraged (optional) to bring the file in before the reception (a day or two) to make sure it plays on our system.

- If you would like to bring it, please call Ramon Aguilar to set up an appointment
- You can forgo an early test, but we cannot guarantee the video/slideshow will work on the day of the reception.
